any years ago (in the '80s), I went on a Danube River cruise. I found the itinerary fantastic, but the ship, which was then latest and greatest, had small cabins and people smoked anywhere. I didn't heavily promote river cruising after that.

Fast forward 30 years... River cruises are now the hottest new form of travel all over the world, particularly in Europe. I have since been on six more river cruises, and I wish I could travel everywhere this way. The new ships are luxurious and gorgeous. They are geared to an American market in terms of comfort, language and interest.

Staterooms are well-designed with luxury features and beautiful bathrooms. The food on all the ships is very good to excellent and almost all include wine or beer with dinner...some even include all alcoholic beverages throughout your trip.

While on your cruise, touring is included each day, and you often have several choices. Most offer additional specialty tours that may involve cooking or wine. Many days these ships dock right in the towns along the river so you can just walk off and be in the heart of everything. If the town is a little further away, there is generally a shuttle provided to take you back and forth from the ship.

River cruises today appeal to many age groups, and are perfect for those who like

active vacations, as most tours involve a fair amount of walking. However, there are also shore tours available for those who cannot maintain a faster pace. Some ships even carry bicycles on board. Shore tours are generally small groups of about 15 people.

River cruise choices seem endless. Cruise the Danube between Prague and Budapest with a stop in Vienna. Or travel the Rhine between Amsterdam and Basel, visiting Cologne, Rudesheim, the castles along the river and more. A Seine sailing is roundtrip Paris, and

visits the Normandy Beaches and Giverney; while a cruise on the Rhone and Saone rivers between Lyon and Avignon feature Southern France's historical sites and wine country. Perhaps Portugal is on your list, or Dante's River Po in Italy. See tulip time in Holland with a stop in Bruges, Belgium. You can even sail to the Black Sea going through Bulgaria, Romania and other fascinating places. And with it all... you only have to pack and unpack once! early 19th centuries, Falmouth was one of the busiest ports in Jamaica. As the shipping trade changed, Falmouth became a sleepy village




